Proceedings Submissions Due by July 30, 2010

Your proposal **MUST** be accepted for presentation by the ABC Program Chair before you submit your paper for the Proceedings.

Why submit your paper?

- The Proceedings will be available on the ABC website.
- The Proceedings provides a wide distribution of your scholarship.
- Completing your paper early gives you more time to prepare your oral presentation.
- Including your paper as part of the Proceedings creates a permanent legacy that can be passed on to your peers for years to come.

What kinds of papers will be considered?

Only complete papers will be included. Literature reviews without the completed research (findings, conclusions) will not be published. Theory and practical articles are also welcome. Only papers that are presented at the convention will be included in the proceedings. Therefore, the proceedings will be published after the conclusion of the convention.

When will publication decisions be made?

- Submissions required by: July 30, 2010
- Acceptances determined by: September 1, 2010
- Revisions will be due by: October 1, 2010
- Proceedings will be published by: December 1, 2010

How are papers submitted?

Complete your paper according to the proceedings formatting instructions and save it as a Word file. Submit your paper as a Word attachment to gueldenzoph@att.net before July 30, 2010.
